



Barn Rules and Regulations

Included in our full-service training program is the use of our indoor arena (with the lights on if needed), the outdoor arena, jump course, the Eurociser, paddocks, round pen and trails. Arenas are groomed and watered daily, and footing is kept in top condition. The Eurociser is raked and watered as needed.

The wash rack has hot and cold water so horses can be bathed year-round.

A tack room is available for clients to keep their horse's belongings and room can be made for clients wishing to bring their own tack lockers.

Clients have access to our heated and air-conditioned viewing lounge with bathrooms, shower and kitchen.

Our hours are Tuesday through Sunday from 9:00am-6:00pm however exceptions can be made if needing to accommodate school and work times.

Your horse will be taken care of 24 hours a day 365 days a year rain or shine. We will blanket when needed, add client provided supplements and offer additional care in case of a medical situation.

Farrier appointments will be scheduled by us for your convenience and we will assist with vet and farrier visits.

We keep a full-time fly spray system running to keep flies down to a minimum and manure is removed daily.

Clients trailers can be parked at no extra charge.

We can haul your horse at any hour of the day or night to a vet clinic in case of an emergency.

We keep our facility in top shape for your animal's safety and wellbeing and repair any damage done by client horses at our own expense.

And now the not as fun part! 😊 Unfortunately, after years of being very lenient when it came to clients using our equipment and products, we now must enforce some rules. The wear and tear on our equipment and the free use of our grooming and tack cleaning products and fly sprays have become too costly for us.

- Tack and equipment owned by OTS is only to be used by OTS and its employees. This includes saddles, bridles, pads, blankets, spurs, fly sprays, grooming products (like show sheen and hoof oil) and tack cleaning products. When we ride your horse, we will groom your horse with our products and if using your tack, we will clean your tack with our products but if you come to ride your horse please use your own products and equipment. If you need to borrow something from us, please ask us first and clean up whatever you borrowed afterwards and put back where it belongs.
- Please do not help yourself to our feed, hay or shavings stack. If you think your horse needs more feed/hay/shavings, then please come talk to us and we will always find a solution.
- Please clean up after yourself and your horse in the cross ties and wash rack.
- Please don't leave large pieces of trash (like boxes) for us to dispose of.
- If you or your horse break something, please let us know so we can fix it.
- Farrier checks need to be brought out before the farrier is working on your horse and need to be made out directly to the farrier. We will give you a heads up when a farrier check is needed. An exception to clients who have horses in training with us but are not present themselves. They will be invoiced for farrier services on their monthly invoice.
